Director's College Scholarship Guidelines and Criteria for Application

*In order to be considered for a Director's College (DC) scholarship,
you must meet the following criteria:*

- Be a front line director, assistant director, or aspiring director of a barbershop chorus, and
- Must commit to becoming a Certified Director *see note*
- Have never received a scholarship to attend Directors College, and
- Can commit to the dates of Directors College **July 27th – August 3rd, 2008**
 - *note – To become a Certified Director you must take specific classes at DC, your District HEP Schools, and your District COTS. This is a curriculum that focuses on directing skills, sound management, music theory, barbershop craft, and leadership.

Please read and follow the below instructions. Failure to follow all instructions will result in invalidating your application.

- Applications must be completed and postmarked to the Society Headquarters between February 1st and March 1st (*unless from overseas, emails will not be accepted*)
- Applications submitted first and that meet all criteria will receive priority...applications sent before the deadline will be asked to be sent again between the requested dates of February 1st and March 1st
- Once all scholarships have been offered, each successive application will be filed in order of receipt and placed on a waiting list
- If for some reason the scholarship award recipient cannot attend DC, the next in line will be offered the scholarship
